Camp sessions are free for all our nation's heroes. No weapons allowed on grounds, most pets allowed.

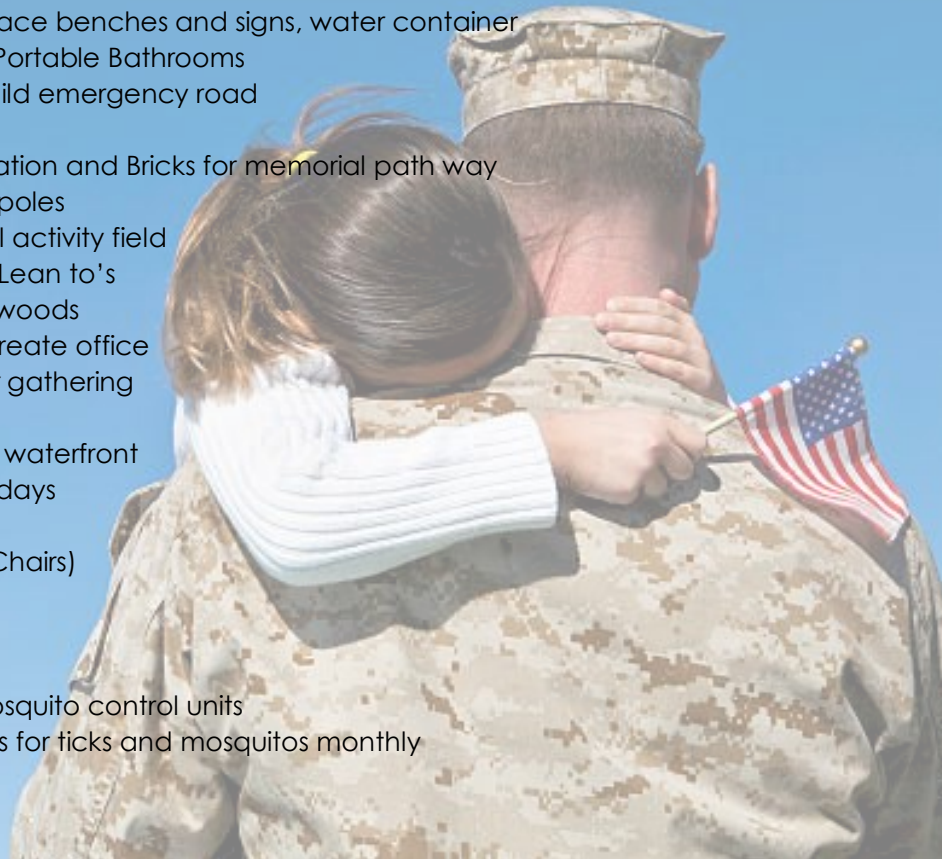
- Friday afternoon to Sunday morning

UNDER CONSTRUCTION BUILDING THE SITE

The road and Bond-Fire pit are completed and we are hard at work preparing the grounds to receive our heroes by ensuring safe, navigable and accessible routes.

To open fully we need the following:

- Completing fire pit area—place benches and signs, water container
- Rent and place Accessible Portable Bathrooms
- Expand Parking Area and Build emergency road
- Tent Platforms and Grills
- Wall Boards with war designation and Bricks for memorial path way
- Permanent signage & 8 flagpoles
- Labor Clear and build small activity field
 - Build storage cabin and Lean to's
 - Build Parcourse through woods
 - Move existing cabin to create office
 - Build Pavilion for outdoor gathering
 - Create grey water area
- Staff—Office, maintenance, waterfront
- Volunteers to staff program days
- 4 Cords of Firewood
- Seating for 20 (Adirondack Chairs)
- 6 Hammocks
- 2 Tetherball Courts
- Sand Volleyball court
- Solar powered lights and mosquito control units
- Pest control spraying services for ticks and mosquitos monthly
- People mover that seats 4
- Pontoon boat that seats 8
